- Prepare work area for safe operation of the scissor lift
- Using of appropriate personal protective equipment in accordance with organisational procedures
- Perform pre-use inspection on scissor lift, its associated components and safety devices/signage/labels
- Perform function checks on scissor lift
- Report all damage and defects and take appropriate action as per organisational procedures

- Be able to listen and speak English at a proficiency level equivalent to the Employability Skills (ES) level 3;
- Be able to read and write English at a proficiency level equivalent to ES level 3;
- Be able to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to ES level 3; and
- Medically fit to work at height.

A Statement of Attainment (SOA) and safety pass will be awarded to successful participants.
