- Be able to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to ES level 4; and
- Be medically fit.

Entry Requirement:

Successfully completed both Rigger course & Signalman course (WSQ/MOM)

Legal Requirement:

The WSH (Operations of Cranes) Regulations stipulates that it shall be the duty of the responsible person:

- → To appoint a Lifting Supervisor before any lifting operation involving the use of any crane is carried out in a workplace."
- → Not to appoint any person as a Lifting Supervisor for any lifting operation involving the use of a mobile or tower crane unless the person is one who
 - (a) has successfully completed a training course acceptable to the Commissioner to equip him to become a Lifting Supervisor; and
 - (b) has, in the opinion of the responsible person, such relevant experience in lifting operations for at least one year."

Certification:

A Statement of Attainment (SOA) and safety pass will be awarded to successful participants.
