The 5S approach:

- SEIRI
 Clear unnecessary items from work area
 SEITON
- Organize work area in an orderly manner
- SEISO Clean work area
- SEIKETSU
 Maintain work area cleanliness
- SHITSUKE
 Maintain self-discipline in work area
- Reducing Wastes at the workplace
- Roles of employees
- 5S Activities
