About the Course:

Apply Workplace Safety and Health in Metal Work is a mandatory WSH training course for all workers working in metal working. Metal working workers are required to successfully go through the course before commencement of work.

Assumed Skills and Knowledge:

Learners must be above 18 years of age and are assumed to:

- Have employment status as manual labour to carry out work in a factory engaged in the manufacture of basic metals, fabricated metal products, machinery or equipment and electrical machinery and Apparatus
- Be medically fit
- Be able to listen, read, speak and write English at a proficiency level equivalent to the Employability Skills (ES) level 2
- Be able to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to Employability Skills (ES) level 2
- Have good organisational skills
- Be able to follow written and oral work instructions

Certification:

A Statement of Attainment (SOA) and safety pass will be awarded to successful participants.

Safety pass which is valid for a period of 2 or 4 years will depend on the participant's years of working experience in the related industry in Singapore.

Important note:

Participants are required to bring their personal document (i.e., NRIC, valid Work Permit or In-Principle Approval and Passport), personal water bottle and wear covered shoes.
