COURSE OUTLINE

Course Aim

A rigging and signaller is one who performs lifting and rigging works and assists in directing lifting operations involving processes such as selecting and using appropriate lifting gear, slinging loads, and signaling crane operators in accordance with WSH rules and regulations pertaining to working in the Process Industry. The work he/she performs includes the following:

- CE 1. Perform lifting operations preparation work
- CE 2. Perform lifting operations
- CE 3. Reinstate lifting operations work area

Learning Objectives

On completion of the course, participants should be able to appreciate the complexity involved in performing critical and complex rigging and/or signalling operations in accordance with relevant codes of practice and regulations pertaining to working in Process Industry.

1. Perform critical lifting operations preparation work
2. Perform critical lifting operations
3. Reinstate critical lifting operations work area

ASSUMED SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

Learners must possess:

- either WSQ Perform Rigger and Signaller Tasks or ITE CoC in Rigging & Signalling- PT&R

Learners are assumed to:

- be physically fit to perform all the required tasks
- be able to listen, read, speak and write English at a proficiency level equivalent to the Employability Skills System (ESS) level 2
- be able to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to Employability Skills System (ESS) level 2
