COURSE OUTLINE

Course Aim

A blaster and painter is the one who performs surface preparation using hand tools, power tools, dry blasting and applies coating on treated metal complex surface using roller, brush or spray painting to prevent surface corrosion and enhance surface finishing so that finished products meet the required international standards and specification

Learning Objectives

This course will equip participants with the knowledge and skills to perform surface preparation using hand tools, power tools, dry blasting and applies coating on treated metal complex surface using roller, brush or spray painting to prevent surface corrosion and enhance surface finishing so that finished products meet the required international standards and specification

1. Maintain safe working environment.
2. Prepare ventilation for blasting / painting
3. Check the condition of blasting equipment and accessories.
4. Set up blasting equipment and accessories.
5. Prepare surface before blasting.
6. Protect unblasted surface of work piece
7. Perform surface preparation.
8. Perform function test on blasting system.
9. Perform abrasive blasting on complex structure
10. Check blasted surface.
11. Maintain blasting equipment and accessories
12. Set up spray painting equipment and accessories.
13. Perform mixing of paints.
14. Perform painting on complex metal surface.
15. Maintain painting equipment and accessories

ASSUMED SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

Learners must be existing Painter and Blaster & complete Certification of Competency in Blasting and Paintwork – PT&R

Learners are assumed to:

- have knowledge of common hazards and necessary safety precautions
- have the ability to read and interpret instructions, diagrams and sketches
- have knowledge of the methods and skills in the use of common equipment, materials and hand tools appropriate for blasting & painting work
- be physically fit to perform all the required tasks
- be able to listen, read, speak and write English at a proficiency level equivalent to the Employability Skills System (ESS) level 2
- be able to manipulate numbers at a proficiency level equivalent to Employability Skills System (ESS) level 2
